Don't Forward Other Email Addresses

Q: I got an email forwarded to me with text and photos and a lot of email addresses it was also sent to. How can I forward it to others without all those email addresses showing?

A: First, click the forward icon, address it, then select the offending text at the top that contains the addresses and hit the delete key. I like to use the Auto Text Cleanup—Remove Quoting from the Edit menu of Entourage 2004 to further tidy up the outgoing email. If you want to complete the effort, edit the subject line, which would include “FW: “ indicating a forwarded email. Feel free to correct any spelling errors. Then send the email. ~ LIMac Forum, Long Is., NY
